Landstreichmusik („Band of Rovers“), a fellowship of innovative Swiss Folk musicians and modern representatives of the ancient European tradition of Wandering Minstrels, took the road in 2010 to spread their astonishing blend of Alpine Roots Music.

Since then they have undergone extensive touring through Switzerland and the neighbouring countries Germany, Austria and Italy.

Every member of the group is a musical vagrant in his own right.

Matthias Lincke and multi-instrumentalist Dide Marfurt (Cittern, Hurdy Gurdy, Bagpipes) build the core of the companionship. A further important element of Swiss Trad is added by Simon Dettwiler. He plays the Schwyzerörgeli, a special kind of Accordion, which is only played in Switzerland.

Christine Lauterburg, well-known for her mastery of Swiss Yodeling combined with her instrumental skills, is the Queen among the members of this alpine „Band of Gypsies“.

After their neo-traditional album „Heiteri Schiibe“ (Narrenschiff, 2013) the four „Roving Minstrels“ now present a folk-pop-song inspired by minimalistic sounds of the 80ies.

They celebrate the multiculturalism of Langstrasse, the notorious red-light-district of Zürich.

In addition to the digital release of „Langstrasse“, the song will be available as 7inch-vinyl-single with an extra track on side B. Furthermore appears a remix by Anselm Caminada and a video clip directed by F. Raymond Sickly (<http://landstreichmusik.ch/langstrass.htm>).
